Data Protection

GENERAL INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ART. 13 AND ART. 21 OF THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

The Department of the Upper Austrian Government and the Upper Austrian District Authorities are data controllers in the sense of the General Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO).¹

The processing of personal data in the Upper Austrian provincial administration is generally carried out on a legal basis (sovereign administration) or with the consent of the data subjects or on a contractual basis (private sector administration²).

The retention period of the individual data processing operations results either from special legal provisions or from the respective data disposal regulations. Pursuant to § 3 of the Upper Austrian Archival law, all documents which are no longer required on a permanent basis, must be provided for transfer to the Upper Austrian Landesarchiv (verification of archival value), after the expiry of a period stipulated by the organizational regulations (data disposal regulations) or after 30 years at the latest (maximum periods).

According to art. 15 et seqq. DSGVO, there is a fundamental right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, objection, and in certain cases processing, objection and, in certain cases, to data portability.

The Austrian Data Protection Authority (www.dsb.gv.at) is responsible for any complaints regarding data protection.

Right of objection pursuant to art. 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation

The data subject shall have the right, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning him or her which is carried out on the basis of art. 6 para. 1 lit. e or f DSGVO; this also applies to profiling based on these provisions.(art. 21 para. 2 DSGVO). According to art. 21 para. 2 DSGVO, there is a right to object in the case of direct marketing.

Please note that an objection is not productive if the data processing is necessary for compelling reasons worthy of protection.
